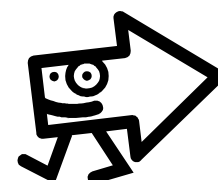

## EXAM NOTES:

1. **Highlight** all those exams that apply to you checking carefully for exams that start/finish outside of normal class times (indicated on the timetable in italics/underline).
2. GCSE Modern Language Orals will be held in January, please see Mr Richards for further details.
3. Contact Mrs Stiff in the Exams Office **ASAP** if you have any exam clashes.
4. All examinations will take place in the Main Hall unless shown otherwise.
5. All coats, bags, etc should be left in the Year 11 Common room and equipment carried into the examination room in a clear, see-through pencil case. Most exams are now required to be written in **BLACK** ink – bring one in for your mocks to get into the habit! Ensure you have the correct equipment for **MATHS** examinations – there will be **NO** spare equipment for loan!
6. Know your candidate number (lists up in my office) and Centre Number (**16201**) and put them on all sheets used.
7. Seating will be by candidate numbers or classes, according to different subject requirements – seating plans will be up during week beginning 30 Nov – **CHECK THEM EARLY**.
8. Handing out papers and collecting in papers can add 5 to 10 minutes to the stated times.
