# The Appleton School Sixth Form Results & Destinations



ACHIEVING EXCELLENCE

Students in our 2017 Year 13 cohort achieved a solid set of results:



- 100% achieved at least one Distinction\* grade level at BTEC Level 3 or at least one A-Level pass.
- 98% of students achieved A\*-E A-Level passes (including equivalents).
- 46% of grades achieved were A\*-B grades (including equivalents).
- 75% of grades achieved were A\*-C grades (including equivalents).
- The average Academic grade was C.

The average Applied General grade was a Distinction\*

- Students resitting English or Maths had a progress grade of +0.67
- Over 90% of students who applied for university secured their top choice university.
- 21.15% students gained a place at a prestigious Russell Group University.
- A 100% Destination rate in total (the percentage of students who continue in education or training, or move on to employment at the end of 16 to 19 study).
- 72% of Year 13 students went to university, 10% found employment and 11% gained an apprenticeship.
- 97% Academic Retention rate, 92% Applied General Retention rate (the percentage of students who get to the end of their study programme).
