

## The Appleton School Sixth Form Results & Destinations

Students in our 2019 Year 13 cohort achieved a solid set of results:



- 100% achieved at least one Distinction\* grade level at BTEC Level 3.
- 100% of students achieved A\*-E A-Level passes.
- 48% of grades achieved were A\*-B A-Level grades.
- 81% of grades achieved were A\*-C grades (including equivalents).
- The average Academic grade was C+.

The average Applied General grade was a Distinction+.

- 90% of students who applied for university secured their top choice university.
- 12% students gained a place at a prestigious Russell Group University.
- A 100% Destination rate in total (the percentage of students who continue in education or training, or move on to employment at the end of 16 to 19 study).
- 72% of Year 13 students went to university, 22% found employment and 6% gained an apprenticeship.
- 100% Academic Retention rate, 100% Applied General Retention rate in Year 13 (the percentage of students who get to the end of their study programme).

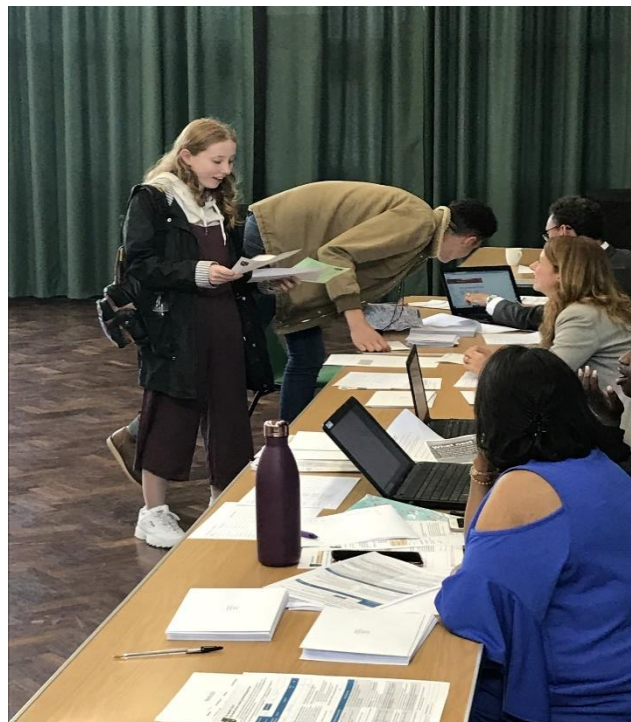


# DESTINATIONS
