ACHIEVING EXCELLENCE

Students in our first ever Year 13 cohort achieved a solid set of results:

- 100% achieved at least one Distinction* grade level at BTEC Level 3 or at least one A-Level pass
- 89% of students achieved 3 A-Level passes (including equivalents)
- 42% of grades achieved were A*-B grades (including equivalents)
- The average grade was C-
- Students resitting English or Maths had a progress grade of +0.8
- 90% of students who applied for university secured their top choice university.
- 11% students gained a place at a prestigious Russell Group University
- A 98% Destination rate in total (the percentage of students who continue in education or training, or move on to employment at the end of 16 to 19 study)
- 65% of Year 13 students went to university, 23% found employment and 9% gained an apprenticeship.
- 100% Academic Retention rate, 95% Applied General Retention rate (the percentage of students who get to the end of their study programme)
