

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Appleton School 2017/18

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 54 pupils that are below the expected standard in reading and 43 pupils are below the expected standard in maths.

During 2017/18 the school is expected to receive approximately £16,000 for the catch-up premium (based on 2016/2017 allocation). This funding will be used for:

- Numeracy with 10 Sessions of 5 groups with teachers on Tuesday before Christmas.
- Literacy sound training.
- Library and Reading project by the Benfleet Teaching Schools Alliance.

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least the expected standard in English and maths.
