

Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium at The Appleton School 2018/19

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 42 pupils that are below the expected standard in reading and 29 pupils are below the expected standard in maths.

During 2018/19 the school is expected to receive approximately £11,000 for the catch-up premium (based on 2017/2018 allocation). This funding will be used for:

- Enhancing additional adult support in lower sets for English and maths lessons.
- English intervention “Making good progress” Tuesday after school with four teachers.
- Maths numeracy has an extra four hour lessons per fortnight.
- English literacy has an extra five hour lessons per fortnight.
- Numeracy Online package “Hegarty Maths” purchased.

The intended impact of the above will be for all pupils to reach at least the expected standard in English and maths.
