Additionally, afterschool and lunchtime clubs will give your child the opportunity to mix with the wider school community; make new friends and develop key social and life skills.

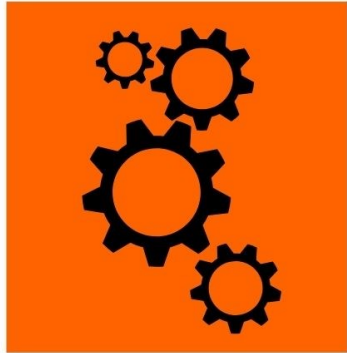
We highly recommend and encourage students to sign up to at least one club this term.
