General Minimum Requirements	In order to study A levels, students will require an average of 40+ points from their best eight GCSEs including at least a 5/6 grade in English and in Mathematics .

Biology	GCSE grade 6 in Biology or grade 6 in Combined Science and a grade 6 in both Maths and English.	No
Business Studies	GCSE grades 5 in both English and Maths.	Yes
Chemistry	GCSE grade 6 in Chemistry or grade 6 in Combined Science and a grade 6 in both Maths and English.	No
Computing	Minimum GCSE grade 6 in Computing/ Computer Science, grade 6 in GCSE Maths and English.	No
Criminology	GCSE grade 5 in English.	Yes
Economics	GCSE grades 5 in English and a grade 6 in Maths.	Yes
English Language	GCSE grade 6 in English Language and English Literature.	No
English Literature	GCSE grade 6 in English Language and English Literature.	No
French	GCSE grade 6 in French.	No
Further Mathematics	GCSE grade 7 in Maths.	No
Geography	GCSE grade 5 in Geography or grade 5 in English and Maths if Geography has not been studied at GCSE.	Yes
German	GCSE grade 6 in German.	No
Government & Politics	GCSE grade 5 in English Language or Literature.	Yes
History	GCSE grade 5 in History or grade 5 in English when History has not been studied at GCSE.	Yes
Law	GCSE grade 5 in English.	Yes

BTEC Business Extended Diploma	GCSE grade 4 in English and in Maths.	Yes
BTEC Performing Arts Extended Certificate	Grade 6 in a Performing Arts subject or a Merit in BTEC Performing Arts plus an audition; or a reference relating to experience in Performing Arts outside the school will be required. GCSE grade 4 in English and Maths.	Yes
BTEC Level 3 National Extended Certificate in Applied Science	Grades 5-5 in Combined Science and a grade 5 in Maths.	Yes
BTEC Sport Extended Diploma	GCSE grade 5 in PE or merit Level 2 BTEC Sport and a grade 5 in English and grade 4 in Maths.	Yes
BTEC Sport Extended Certificate	GCSE Grade 5 in PE or merit Level 2 Sport and a grade 5 in English and a grade 4 in Maths.	Yes

Students who wish to study an A Level qualification alongside their BTEC course must also meet the subject entry requirements for their chosen A Level course.

For a 4 A-Level programme an average of **50+ points** from your best 8 GCSEs must be attained. You must also meet the subject specific entry requirements of the courses you select.

Calculating Your Point Score

To calculate your average GCSE points score; use the table below to determine the points that each grade equates to. Add together the points awarded to your best eight GCSEs and divide that total by eight.
